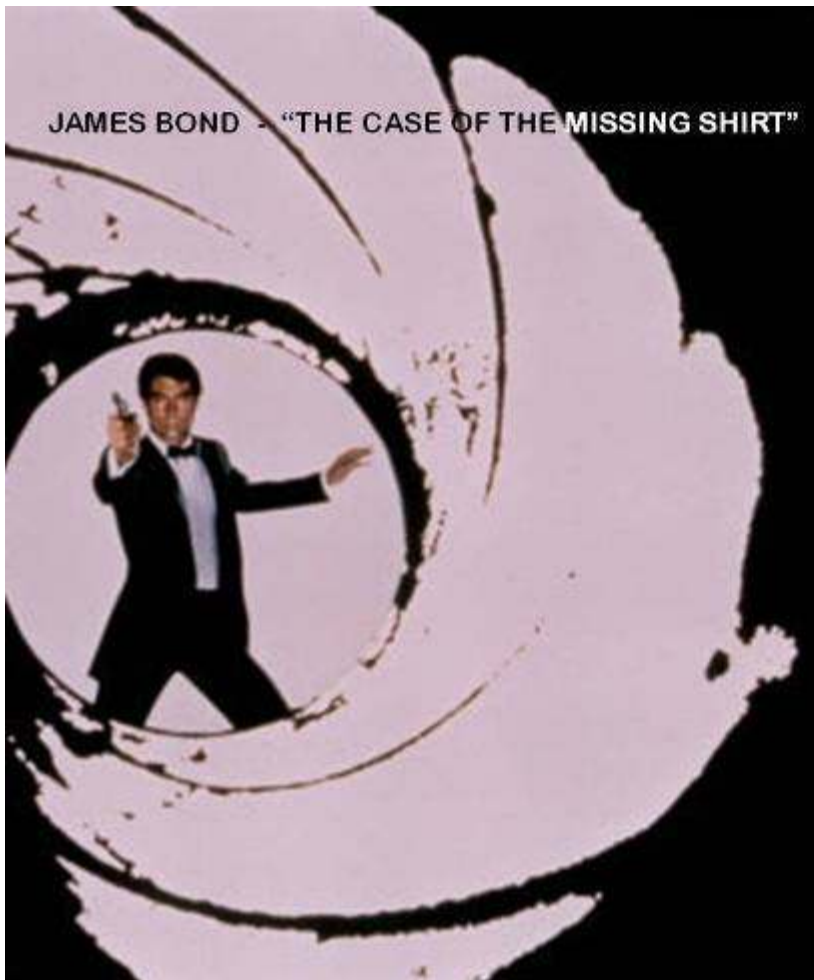
SGL Weekly Newsletter – 6th Oct 2009
